YOUTH NIGHT QUESTIONS and ANSWERS for PARENTS:

How will the sleeping arrangements be?

- Girls and boys will be separated at "Separation Time". Boys will be sleeping in the MPR Room on carpeted floor. Girls will be sleeping in the Choir area in the Worship area on carpeted floor. Youth will be prohibited from going outside of the church after separation unless they need to use the restroom. The boundary includes 40 foot of space and chairs with a partition between the Boys' and girls' sleeping areas. Boys and Girls will be unable to see, hear or have any physical contact with each other after the separation time. Adult leaders will be within visual distance of youth sleeping. Adult leaders are prohibited from sleeping by (within 10 feet) youth participants. After 12 am ALL male leaders and participants are prohibited from entering the Worship area where female participants are sleeping and vice versa. Each sleeping area will have at least 2 adults supervising the area at all times. After separation time Adult male and female leader will only be able to communicate by phone or congregating in the front of the church, outside of the sleeping areas. There will be rotations of Adult leaders awake the entire night available to escort kids to the restroom.

What are the procedures of youth using rest room?

- There are 3 restrooms in St. Jude. One is in the main office. The other restrooms are located at the end of the church by the office entrance. Youth are not allowed to use the office restroom. Youth are to use the restroom either escorted by 2 adult leaders of the same gender or by going to restroom with a group of youth and one adult leader. When restroom is being used, leaders and youth are to wait outside restroom area until the last youth is done. Male and female participants will be prohibited from being in the restroom areas at the same time. There should always be one adult leader waiting outside the restroom area while youth are using restroom. After the last child is done using the restroom, participants will be escorted by adult leader(s) straight to designated gathering area.

Who are the leaders watching over my child?

- The leaders of this event come from St. Jude Kapolei. All leaders have attended the Safe Environment and Recognizing Child Abuse Compliance classes provided by the Diocese of Honolulu. All leaders have been certified in CPR and First Aid.
